CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION

Items 1-3 are mandatory for consideration:

1. Has competitive success as a coach. Has been coaching a minimum of 15 years and has approximately 20 national placements by a number of different athletes.
2. Has demonstrated technical expertise and is currently an Advanced coach.
3. Must write a short paper on "Why I should be an Elite coach."
4. Has created other successful coaches.
5. Has contributed to the profession through official NGB programs and publications, given seminars, served on national committees, etc.
6. Has had such an impact on the people they come in contact with that a permanent interest in roller-skating is created (i.e. having former students still in skating in some capacity).
7. Has exhibited fair and sportsmanlike deportment.
8. Has a willingness to be a continuing resource for the federation.
9. Has been a skating judge or has had some judging experience or has helped train judges panels.
10. Has taught more than one discipline of skating (i.e. figures and singles, singles and pairs, dance and free skating, figure and speed).
11. Has been a role model in their words and deeds for roller-skating and has knowledge of roller-skating history.
